

AUCTIONEER QUALIFICATIONS (NSW)

To be accredited as an auctioneer, applicants will need to satisfy qualification requirements in connection with the conduct of auctions and the functions of auctioneers. The auctioneer qualification requirements are set out in the Commissioner's Order published in the Government Gazette on 1 September 2003.

The qualification requirements are:

- **for a real estate agent to be accredited to act as an auctioneer, competence must be demonstrated in PRDRE26A *Conduct property sale by auction* from the *Property development and management training package (PRD01) - Real estate sector***
- **for a stock and station agent to be accredited to act as an auctioneer, competence must be demonstrated PRDSSA23A *Conduct auction sale* and PRDSSA32A *Conduct livestock sale by auction* from the *Property development and management training package (PRD01) - Stock and station sector*.**

The new competency based requirements include the units of competency required for auctioneer accreditation.
