Church of England and Methodist  
 Portions, Curra Creek General Cemetery.

It is desired to thank you for the information conveyed in your letter of 15th June, 1954, the delay in answering which is regretted.

I wish to inform you that there are at present no trustees for the Presbyterian and Other Denominations Portions of the cemetery. The Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Bathurst, however, are trustees for the Roman Catholic Portion. In addition to H. Cosier and yourself, the Resident Methodist Minister for the time being in the Wellington Circuit is also a trustee of the Methodist Portion.

In view of the fact that the cemetery has not been used for a considerable number of years, and that no finance is handled by the trustees of the subject Portions, submission of financial statements and reports each year will not be insisted upon. However, the trustees are obliged to notify this Department immediately should the existing circumstances alter in the future.

Please bring the contents of this letter to the attention of the trustees for both the Church of England and Methodist Portions of the Cemetery.
