House & slab cottage.

The house is a good example of a country vernacular cottage dating from the Federation era. It is an attractive and intact rural cottage (c.1900) with decorative cast iron brackets to timber verandah posts, Flemish bond brickwork, corrugated iron roof and bull-nose verandah. The slab cottage (c.1867) is an interesting and rare example of a mid 19th century dwelling still used for habitable purposes.

Currently a private residence.
